In fact we are paying almost 1700% more for using exactly the same facility. It's unfair and it's unjust and the ONLY reason it has not been

If all individual members of clubs associated with the B&W paid just £1 each, there would be no financial loss to the B&W and a much fairer system would be in place. This is the favoured option, but it is up to the member clubs to embrace it, accept it, endorse it and get on with it. **May common sense prevail!**
